



PROCEDURES FOR WORK COMPLETED WITHOUT THE REQUIRED INSPECTIONS

FBC 110.1 REQUIRES ALL WORK TO 'REMAIN ACCESSIBLE AND EXPOSED FOR INSPECTION PURPOSES UNTIL APPROVED'.

A FLORIDA LICENSED PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER/ARCHITECT SHALL SUBMIT A COMPREHENSIVE REPORT AND PLAN CERTIFYING ALL COMPLETED STRUCTURAL WORK BY PERFORMING EXPLORATORY WORK SUFFICIENT TO VERIFY COMPLIANCE WITH THE BUILDING CODE IN EFFECT AT THE TIME THE PERMIT WAS ISSUED.

REPORT IS TO INCLUDE:

- VERIFICATION OF ALL ASPECTS OF THE MISSED INSPECTIONS AND CONCEALED WORK, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, FRAMING, ATTACHMENTS, INSULATION, FIRE CAULKING, DRYWALL, CEILING GRID, TIE-BEAMS/COLUMNS, CMU, TRUSSES, STEEL, SLABS., FIREWALLS, ETC.*
- IF THE REPORT FINDS DEFICIENCIES, CORRECTIONS MUST BE MADE
- ALL PHOTOGRAPHS MUST 8.5" X 11", IN COLOR AND LABELED, IDENTIFYING THE WORK BEING CERTIFIED AND MUST INCLUDE THE JOBSITE ADDRESS
- ALL PAGES OF REPORT ARE TO BE NUMBERED, SIGNED, SEALED & DATED ON ENGINEER'S/ARCHITECT'S LETTERHEAD.
- THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE METHODOLOGY USED FOR INSPECTION
- UPLOAD ALL THE REQUIRED DOCUMENTS INTO THE ONLINE SYSTEM FOR REVIEW

IF PERMIT IS EXPIRED, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO RE-OPEN PERMIT.

UPON APPROVAL OF YOUR PERMIT, SCHEDULE YOUR FINAL INSPECTION & HAVE PERMIT CARD, PLANS AND THE VERIFICATION REPORT ALONG WITH AN APPROVED LADDER, IF NECESSARY, FOR THE FIELD INSPECTOR.
