16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
17 MARGATE, FLORIDA:

19 SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 2013-8 adopting the
20 budget for the City of Margate, Florida, for the period
21 beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014, is
22 hereby amended, as set out in Exhibit A, a copy of which is
23 attached hereto and specifically made a part of this
24 Ordinance.

26 SECTION 2: That all ordinances or resolutions or parts
27 of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith be, and
28 the same are, hereby repealed to the extent of such
29 conflict.

31 SECTION 3: That if any section, sentence, clause, or
32 phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or
33 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, then
34 said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the
35 remaining portions of this ordinance.

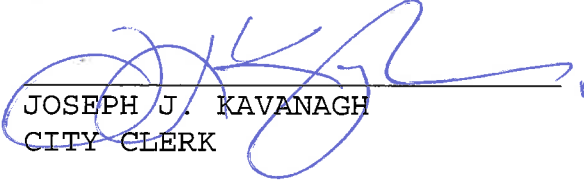
37 SECTION 4: That this ordinance shall become effective
